The Resort features two par seventy-one courses; Carroll Valley - the older of the two - was built in 1968 and has one of the most unique layouts you will find anywhere.

Designed by Ault & Clark and awarded four and one half stars from Golf Digest's 2002 Places to Play, Carroll Valley offers a big layout with six par threes and five par fives. The course has a stream meandering through it, which fronts five of the greens. Carroll Valley also has a rather large fresh water lake with outstanding views of the course. "You will definitely use all of the clubs in your bag, and probably a ball retriever if you have one," says Phil Delpopolo, head PGA professional at Carroll Valley.

The second of the two courses at the Resort is the Mountain View Golf Course. Built in 1978, this course provides an entirely different set of challenges and is also designed by Ault & Clark. Located less than three miles from the entrance of the Resort, The Mountain View offers a great compliment to its sister course. At Mountain View every hole goes in a different direction. The back nine winds through and around tight tree lines and ponds. The Mountain View course was awarded a Four Star rating from Golf Digest and features a natural grass driving range and a pre-Civil War pro shop.

Both courses are open to the public and hotel guests with the most desirable tee times booked months in advance with travelers from all over the world.

The Resort arguably has the best year round playing conditions in Pennsylvania.

"Tom Sanders, our Superintendent does an outstanding job of keeping our courses in championship form all year," said Pastoor. "We are so proud of the way our staff interacts with and services our golfers, and to have our courses in such great playing condition all the time is quite a bonus," added Pastoor.



"Once our golfers play and stay here we will see them back year after year. I have groups that travel hundreds of miles every year to come back to us," said Delpopolo. "We are proud of the amount of golfers we see coming here every year, some for the past 20 years," he added.
